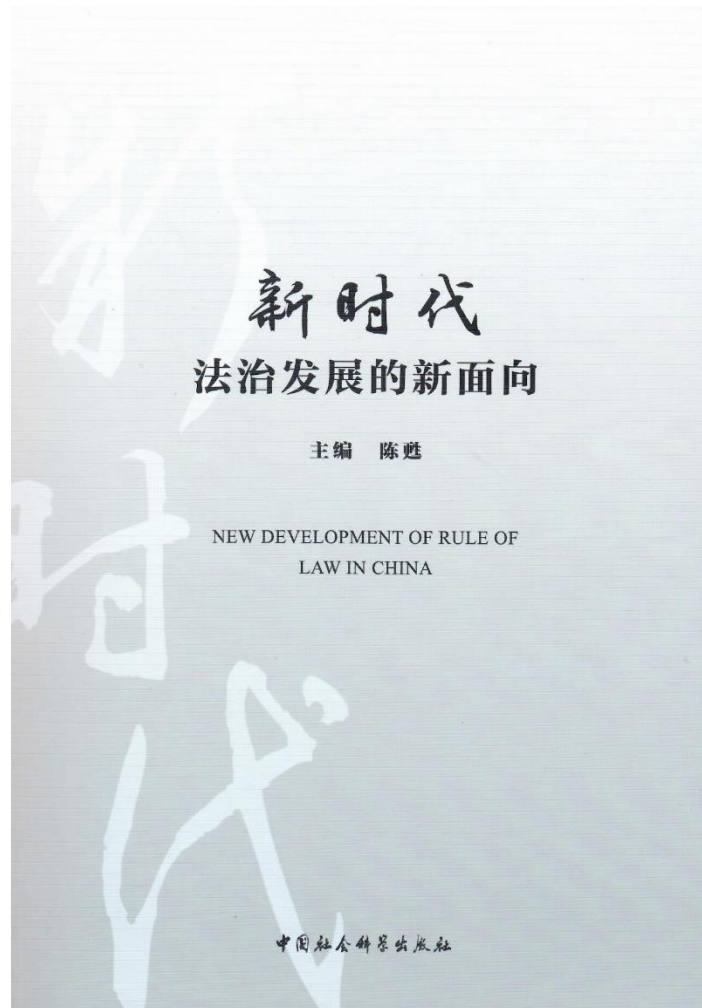


Latest Book: New Development of the Rule of Law in China
