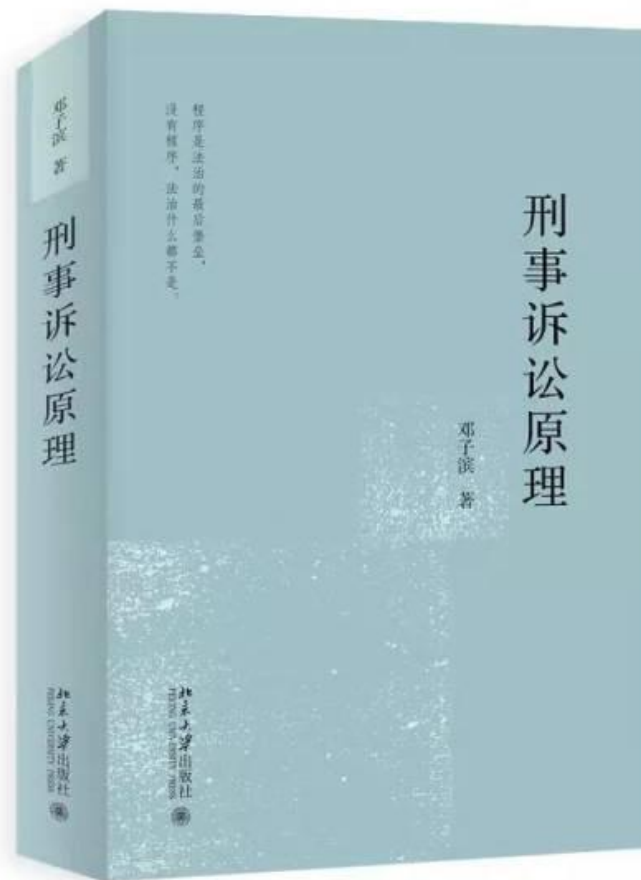


Latest Book: Theory of Criminal Procedure

This book is a systematic research on the principles of criminal procedure independently completed by Professor Deng Zhibin, a research fellow at the Institute of Law, Chinese Academy of Social Sciences. In the book, the author describes with careful observations, vivid language, and clear thoughts an ideal system of criminal procedure in his own eye on the basis of his 25 years' experience as part-time practicing lawyer. The book is intended by the author as a tribute to his mentor, Professor Chen Xinliang, as well as a thought experiment of his own, which is supported by his faith in procedural justice. The author firmly believes that procedural justice is a solid shield that protects freedom - without procedure, freedom is nothing but an empty talk - and that drawing on and sincerely practicing universally recognized ideas and rules of procedural justice is the only way to litigation civilization in China. The book can be used as transdisciplinary reference material in the teaching of criminal law and criminal procedure law.
